Wastewater Collection Improvements Project in the Tijuana River Area of Tijuana, Baja California
International Bid Notice No. 001

The local water utility, *Comisión Estatal de Servicios Públicos de Tijuana* (CESPT or the Executing Agency), has received a grant from the North American Development Bank (NADBank) through its Border Environment Infrastructure Fund (BEIF), which is funded by contributions from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), as set forth in Grant Agreement **BEIF BC1327**, to finance part of the costs associated with the Wastewater Collection Improvements Project in the Tijuana River Area of Tijuana, Baja California (the "Project").

CESPT intends to contract the services of a consulting firm to carry out the following tasks: **"Management, coordination and supervision of the rehabilitation of the Cochimies sewer main in the Kino, Guaycura and Baja Maq el Águila subdivisions in the municipality of Tijuana, Baja California and rehabilitation of the Colinas de la Presa sewer main in the municipality of Tijuana, Baja California."** The Project consists of replacing 10,884 meters of polyvinyl chloride (PVC) pipeline in 13 components of the wastewater collection system, which are deteriorated and generating untreated wastewater discharges into the Tijuana River through several gates in the concrete canal of the Tijuana and Alamar Rivers. The services will consist of verifying that the construction work is carried out in accordance with the final designs, specifications and established standards, as well as monitoring project performance and the use of funds provided by NADBank.

Bidding for contracts financed by NADBank is open to firms from any country. Because the funding for this project is administered by NADBank, the bidding process will be carried out in accordance with its procurement policies and procedures. Companies that have been previously penalized or had contracts cancelled by any public entity are not eligible to participate in the bidding process.

Qualified interested companies are hereby invited to submit technical and financial bids in Spanish in a sealed envelope, for a fixed-term, work-order-based contract to carry out the aforesaid services. This competitive process will be conducted electronically; therefore, the consultants must submit their proposals via <https://comprasmx.buengobierno.gob.mx/>, and as usual submit a physical copy of the proposal as stipulated in the bid terms and conditions governing this procurement process.

Bids may be presented in U.S. dollars or Mexican pesos. Monthly invoices will be paid in the currency indicated in the bid. For the purposes of bid evaluation only, the exchange rate published in the *Diario Oficial de la Federación* for the settling of obligations denominated in foreign currency payable in Mexico, will be used. The date used as the basis for the conversion will be six calendar days prior to the date for opening the bids.

No advance payment for these services will be provided.

The duration of this work is approximately 225 calendar days. The probable start-up and completion dates for the work are July 20, 2026, and March 1, 2027, respectively.

Bid documents will be obtained via the Internet at <https://comprasmx.buengobierno.gob.mx>; however, the general requirements outlined in the bid documents that bidders must meet are as follows:

1. Brief description of the company, its organization and services.
2. Companies interested in providing the services must have at least five (5) years of experience in supervising construction work of a comparable complexity and similar or greater size.
3. Details concerning the experience required for the work advertised, gained over the last five (5) years, including a brief description of the activities performed, amount contracted, duration of the work and the personnel who participated.
4. Contact name and phone number for at least three references for projects completed within the past five (5) years.
5. Curriculum vitae of staff available to work on this project. Consideration will only be given to the CVs of those persons that have direct experience in hydraulic and wastewater infrastructure and who have the ability to work in Spanish.

A **visit to the site** where the services will be provided will be made on the dates and at the times indicated above. The meeting point will be the Assistant Technical Office of CESPT, located at Boulevard Federico Benítez número 4057-C, Colonia 20 de Noviembre, C. P. 22430, Tijuana, Baja California, Mexico. The visit to the site where the services will be provided is optional for interested bidders and is intended to help them become familiar with the environmental conditions and other factors that could affect the complexity of the work and their technical implications.

Likewise, a **Pre-bid Meeting** will be held virtually on the dates and at the times indicated above, which will be conducted electronically by the Assistant Technical Office of CESPT, located at CESPT, Subdirección Técnica, Boulevard Federico Benítez número 4057-C, Colonia 20 de Noviembre, C. P. 22430, Tijuana, Baja California, Mexico. Once the questions duly received (via the designated digital platform) have been addressed, CESPT will provide the responses to the questions as a minute of the pre-bid meeting or as a Clarification Addendum to the procurement documents, as deemed necessary, and said response shall be published on the website at <https://comprasmx.buengobierno.gob.mx>.
